### PROGRAM

- Introductions
- Equipment: choosing equipment; fitting harness & lead correctly
- Tracking demonstration
- Practical: getting the nose down and following a track (10 m, 100 m)
- Theory: how dogs track
- **Morning tea** (discussion: what to wear when tracking; component tracking)
- Practical: following a track with turns and articles (100 – 150 m)
- **Lunch**
- Practical: 150 m track, 1 turn, 2 articles on the track; tracks staggered so all handlers can follow/watch each dog as it tracks
- Theory: flags/track markers; articles; training plan; tracklaying; handling skills; recommended reading; trialing etiquette; questions
- **Wrap up** (evaluation sheets; presentation of certificates)
